

Profile of David R. Koenig



David R. Koenig is the Founding Partner of Ductibility, LLC, a private research and advisory network serving Boards of Directors and senior executives.

He served as the Chair of the Board of Directors of the Professional Risk Managers' International Association (PRMIA) from 2002 – 2005 and was the Executive Director of PRMIA and President of the PRMIA Institute from their inception until September, 2007.

David's work on risk management and governance has been internationally recognized. In 2008, he was chosen as the recipient of PRMIA's top honor, the Higher Standard Award, honoring the contributions of an individual to the global risk profession. In 2007, David was named by his industry peers as one of the first 100 members of the RWI international honorary society, a select group in individuals who have influenced the international practice of risk management.

David is a member of the UK-based Institute of Directors and has more than two decades of managerial and front-line experience in the financial markets, including the development of three corporate risk management programs. Prior to his time with PRMIA, he served as the Head of Market and Institutional Credit Risk Management for US Bancorp Piper Jaffray and has held lead risk management roles with GMAC/RFC and Principal Residential Mortgage, Inc. (a member of the Principal Financial Group).

David's work has included the active management of over \$50 billion in nominal exposures and the design of numerous educational programs in finance and risk management. David began his career with the First National Bank of Chicago.

Publications by Mr. Koenig include work in the areas of governance, Enterprise Risk Management, compensation and incentives design, risk management program design and the influences of psychology and complexity on risk.

He is an Editorial Board Member of the International Journal of Services Sciences (IJSSc) and the Journal of Risk Management in Financial Institutions (JRMFI). David is the Special Editor (with Dr. John Birge, University of Chicago) of "Innovations in Risk Management: New Advances of Risk Management in Services" (forthcoming, IJSSc) and the Special Editor of "The Blind Spots of Risk Management" (forthcoming, JRMFI). In addition, he has been a featured industry speaker at over thirty risk management and finance events on four continents.

Mr. Koenig has a Masters degree in Economics from Northwestern University in Evanston, IL, as well as Bachelor degrees in Mathematics and Economics and a Certificate in Statistics from Miami University in Oxford, OH, where he was a member of the Pi Mu Epsilon Mathematics Honor Society.
